To whom it may concern:

This summer 2005 Centennial Hall at the University of Minnesota contracted with APEIRON Inc. to resurface the Centennial Hall lobby granite floor and stairway landings. The lobby at Centennial Hall is approximately 2300ft. /sq. The resurfacing utilized a two step process. The first step was to remove any scratches in the floor using the scratch removal discs. The second step was to polish the floor using a white floor pad and the "wet polish" polishing compound provided by APEIRON Inc. The polishing process went smoothly and was completed in a timely manner. The quality and appearance of the floor surface was excellent.

While Centennial Hall was closed for winter break this Christmas season we merely had to re-buff the polished floor traffic areas to bring back the floor luster.

I would recommend this polishing system to any facility with stone care needs. It has saved us many many hours of labor not having to strip floor finish or recoat.
